OCU LAW Announces First Recipient of Professorship in Trial Advocacy

(OKLAHOMA CITY – August 30, 2011) – Oklahoma City University School of Law's Professor Dan Morgan is the first recipient of the Norman & Edem Professorship in Trial Advocacy. The Oklahoma City law firm of Norman & Edem, PLLC. established the professorship at OCU LAW during last year's *Seize the Moment* capital campaign.
